Reconfirmation Meeting for **APRIL**

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

March 1, the district began providing in-person option. Only the students whose parents indicated that their students would return on March 1, began at that time. The next phase will return at the start of 4th quarter. As we prepare to welcome back students, and continue to serve students remotely, the district will follow the attached updates to the ELP as developed by the district administrative team.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Elementary (Grades K - 6):

Students in K-6 will receive 240 minutes of direct instruction via Google Classroom. They will also have the ability to access small group or one-on-one instruction during teacher's 150 minutes of "office hours".

Teachers will be encouraged to record their direct instruction and make it available to students and families for review.

Middle School (Grades 7 - 8):

Students in 7-8 will receive 240 minutes of direct instruction via Google Classroom. They will also have the ability to access small group or one-on-one instruction during teacher's 150 minutes of "office hours".

Teachers will be encouraged to record their direct instruction and make it available to students and families for review.

High School (Grades 9 - 12):

Students in 7-8 will receive 240 minutes of direct instruction via Google Classroom. They will also have the ability to access small group or one-on-one instruction during teacher's 150 minutes of "office hours".

Teachers will be encouraged to record their direct instruction and make it available to students and families for review.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

Students are offered one-to-one, or two-person group sessions for extra help or support.
